Welcome Letter from the Principal

Welcome to Stella Maris Academy, home of the Monarchs. We are a Roman Catholic school in the Diocese of San Diego, serving students in grades kindergarten through eight. The school was founded in 1947 as the parish school of Mary, Star of the Sea Catholic Church. The school is fully accredited by both the *Western Association of Schools and Colleges* and the *Western Catholic Education Association*, and is a nationally recognized Blue Ribbon School of Excellence.

Our mission to provide a Christ-centered, academically excellent, and safe school environment which all children can achieve their maximum God-given potential is supported by a challenging curriculum that integrates state and national core standards with the teaching of the Catholic Church. Religious education is a priority, with prayer, sacraments, and liturgy as important components of school life. The school is authentically Catholic, yet warmly welcomes students of all faith traditions. Teachers are highly qualified professionals who model the belief that Christ is the reason for our school by nurturing the children in our care.

Our school-wide learning expectations are that students will be knowledgeable/concerned Catholics who recognize the need to know, love, and serve God; healthy achievers who take responsibility for their own learning; community minded individuals who perform service to improve the lives of others; and morally sensitive individuals who are developing a moral conscience in harmony with unchanging Christian principles.

The use of technology is an important aspect of our educational program. Teachers and students use computers throughout the school day. Our campus is equipped with wireless network access, SMART Boards, multimedia projectors, and document cameras. Technology tools are routinely used to support meaningful and effective teaching and learning.

Our facilities demonstrate good stewardship by our community. Current enrollment is 200, with one class per grade. The campus includes nine classrooms, library, computer lab, science/art lab, administrative offices, and a learning resource center.

The majority of graduates attend Cathedral Catholic, Academy of Our Lady of Peace, and St. Augustine High School. Local public and private schools also include La Jolla High, Bishops, La Jolla Country Day, and Francis Parker. After high school many Stella Maris Academy alumni go on to graduate from prestigious colleges and universities.

Stella Maris Academy is a Christ-centered community where the academic traditions of our past point the direction for our students' futures.

Admissions Process

Stella Maris Academy follows a selective admission policy. In early spring, all applicants will be assessed for developmental readiness to ensure proper placement, and the parents will have a meeting with the principal. Students entering grades 1-8, where appropriate, are required to submit prior school records, recommendations, and standardized testing results.

Stella Maris Academy does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national or ethnic origin in administration of its educational and admissions policies, athletic programs, or other school administered programs.

Admissions Age Requirements

Kindergarten entry: A child must be five years of age by September 1st.

First Grade entry: A child must be six years of age by September 1st.

- ◆ Send the Recommendation form to your child's current school.
- ◆ Completed recommendation form should then be mailed directly to Stella Maris Academy by the school.
- ◆ Applications are not considered complete until the Recommendation form has been received.

□ Request for Records (Grades 1-8 only)

- ◆ Send the Request for Records to your child's current school.
- ◆ A transcript of grades and copies of standardized testing should then be mailed directly to Stella Maris Academy by the school.
- ◆ Applications are not considered complete until Student Records have been received.

□ Principal / Parent Meeting

- ◆ When Application, Recommendation, and Student Records have all been received by Stella Maris Academy, a parent meeting will be scheduled with our principal, Mrs. Patricia Lowell .

□ Student Assessment (Developmental readiness for Kindergarten; Skills for grades 1-8)

- ◆ Kindergarten through Eighth grade assessments will be scheduled in early spring after the Principal/Parent meeting has taken place. These assessments are conducted by the Teacher of the student's incoming grade level.
- ◆ An assessment fee of \$30 is required at the time of the assessment.

□ Additional Records

- ◆ Copies of Immunization Records, Birth Certificate and Baptismal Certificate (when applicable) are all required at time of registration.
