

DAILY UNIFORM

SKIRTS/SKORTS/SHIRTS - GIRLS ONLY

Christopher Plaid shift/dress (K-3), skort, or skirt.

Shift, skirt, or skort are to be no shorter than 2" above the knee.

Shorts must be worn underneath skirt or shift

PANTS/SHORTS - BOYS & GIRLS (NO CARGO PANTS/POCKETS)

Navy Blue Pants/Walking Shorts (K-6) (*Gr. 6 Boys must wear a black or brown belt at all times*)

Khaki Pants/Walking Shorts (7-8) (*Gr. 7-8 Boys must wear a black or brown belt at all times*)

SHIRTS - (SMA LOGO REQUIRED) - BOYS & GIRLS - Shirts must be tucked in at all times

Solid white short or long sleeve polo (K-8), Gr. 7 may wear yellow polo; Gr. 8 may wear dark green polo

SWEATSHIRT - (SMA LOGO REQUIRED) - BOYS & GIRLS

Navy blue crewneck or hooded sweatshirt or navy blue, fleece, zip front jacket

SOCKS (NO LOGOS OR DESIGNS; Socks must be mid-calf height. No low-cut or no-show socks)

BOYS: White or navy blue crew sock (mid-calf height)

GIRLS - White crew (mid-calf height) or knee socks; plain or cable knit tights

SHOES (NO LOGOS) - (low top only)

BOYS: Solid black lace up athletic shoes with black laces

GIRLS: Solid white lace up athletic shoes with white laces

MASS/FORMAL UNIFORM

Any part of the Mass/Formal Uniform may be worn with daily uniform

GIRLS: Christopher Plaid skirt (K-8), Christopher Plaid shift/dress (K-3)

White, Peter Pan collar blouse with SMA logo on left sleeve, *with Navy Blue Crossover Tie*

SOCKS: BOYS - White or Navy blue socks only; **GIRLS** - White knee socks only

SHOES: BOYS - Black or Brown lace up dress shoes

GIRLS -Black & White saddle shoes, or all Black Mary Jane, 1" or less heel height, closed toe & heel

SWEATER for BOYS & GIRLS: Navy blue V-Neck Cardigan, Pullover, or Vest with SMA Logo

BOYS PANTS: Navy Blue Pants (K-6)/Khaki Pants (7-8) (*Gr. 6-8 must wear a black or brown belt*)

BOYS SHIRT: White, long sleeve, button down, dress shirt, *with Navy Blue Neck or Clip On Tie*

JACKETS & COATS: Navy Blue Only; **RAIN GEAR:** Navy Blue, Black, White, or Yellow **NO UMBRELLAS**

HAIR: Conservative style and clean; no bleach or dyes. **BOYS'** hair must be cut above eyes, ears, and collar.

HAIR ACCESSORIES: GIRLS ONLY - **Solid** Navy Blue, Black, White, or Christopher Plaid

JEWELRY: BOYS ONLY - maximum of 1 bracelet, 1 necklace, 1 ring per hand, and 1 watch

GIRLS ONLY - maximum of 1 pair of post style earrings, 1 bracelet, 1 necklace, 1 watch, and 1ring per hand

MAKE-UP: None; NAIL POLISH: None; SKIN DECORATIONS: None

NON-UNIFORM POLICIES FOR ALL STUDENTS:

*Clothes are to be fitted, modest, clean, and presentable - not baggy, low-rider, or rolled up; dresses, skirts, and shorts are to be no shorter than two inches above the knee. **ATHLETIC SHOES ONLY.** The same jewelry, make-up, and hair (but not hair accessory) rules as listed apply to non-uniform days.*

GENERAL UNIFORM POLICIES

*Students are **REQUIRED** to be in proper uniform at all times (exceptions will be noted). Clothes and shoes are to be fitted, modest, clean and presentable - not baggy, low rider, or rolled up; dresses, skirts and shorts are to be no shorter than two inches above the knee; shirts must be tucked in at all times.*

Please label all clothing with student's name. Unlabeled clothing may go to the used uniform closet or Casa de las Pobres.

Parents and students are responsible for adhering to all the uniform policies. A student (Gr. 4-8) may receive a Uniform Citation if they are not following the uniform policy. This citation will result in the loss of Free Dress day privileges.
